The relations between India and Vietnam can be traced back to the Asian Relations Conference held in New Delhi in 1947, or even before, dating back to more than 78 years of bilateral relations. The formal diplomatic ties were later established in 1972, which is marked by mutual respect for sovereignty and a shared vision towards regional stability. The partnership has evolved into cooperation across several sectors. However, the first agreement between India and Vietnam, signed in 1976, was inter-governmental, and focused on political and diplomatic relations. 

India's Trade with Regional Block





India's Exports to MGC





India's Imports from MGC




